Storm is not so good with his people! He is a clumsy horse and sometimes steps on my feet. But he is a very friendly horse and he tries his best.

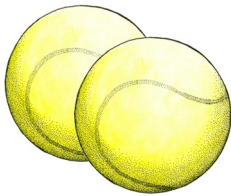

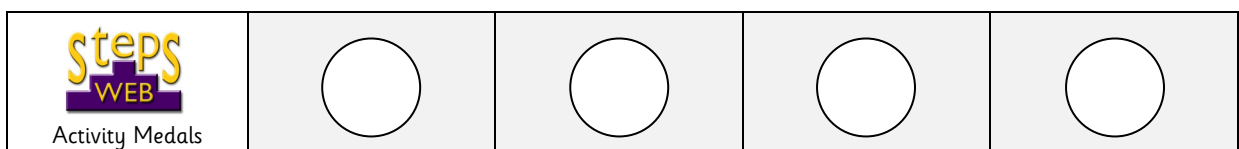

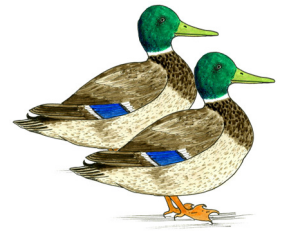
